Job Description

This entry-level position updates, maintains, and analyzes all economic and demographic data used in our research. Typical daily activities include:

- Locate and collect data from standard and specialized federal, state, and local government sites. Examples of typical data collected include those from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, U.S. Census Bureau, U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis, Colorado Department of Labor and Employment, Colorado State Demography Office, and others.
- Manage and manipulate databases, including regular data updating and organizing data in a manner that allows efficient extraction of data and insertion into reports and studies.
- Conduct analytical and statistical analysis of economic data, identifying key trends and providing interpretation of results.
- Research and write a variety of monthly, quarterly, and annual economic reports based on economic and demographic data. These reports need to convey complex trends and information in a simple, concise manner to a business audience.
- Collaborate with and assist other team members with research and data collection related to our four service areas.

Minimum Qualifications

The ideal candidate will have an interest in regional economic development, real estate development, and/or community development issues and at least a bachelor's degree in economics or a related field.

The ideal candidate will have skills and experience as follows:

• A strong familiarity with various economic data sources and their interpretation.

- Strong writing skills, with the ability to present complex economic trends in a concise and simple manner.
- Detail-oriented, with data organization and management skills.
- Ability to work on a variety of projects at the same time.

- Experience with Microsoft Access and ArcView GIS is desired, but not required.
